1. Southern Districts Colts - Touring Team match on Wednesday, 5 December

Driffield RUFC has a long history with this <u>Club</u> based in southern Sydney, and has exchanged players for many years. Their Colts side is currently touring the UK and is stopping off for a game in a weeks' time, which will kick-off at 18.30 on the floodlit pitch.

Because of the late rearranging of their tour, we need volunteers to offer a bed for the night for one or more of the 32-strong tour party.

The proposed timetable is:

- late afternoon: Southern Districts arrive for pre-match prep
- 18:30 : kick-off
- 21:00 : meal in the club house for players and Alecadoos (can anyone wanting to eat let us know in good time)
- followed by a few drinks, before departing to various billets
- Thursday morning: meet at the club for full English breakfast and farewells to the Aussies.

7. Payment on the gate for Ist XV games

If you are able to come along to these games, you will know that new arrangements are in place to take the gate money, which is a valuable source of income for the Club. The new way of operating requires fewer volunteers, and allows parking to be better controlled.

We wanted all members aware of the following points:

- everyone except players and match officials is asked to pay: life members, stakeholders, everyone
- once the club car park is full we **must** use the overflow car park
- parking on the Showground access road is not permitted by the Show Committee
- parking on verges may cause a highway obstruction enforceable by the police

Playing statistics for Club started to be rigorously recorded in the 1995/96 season, and we also have summary data for 1st and 2nd teams that were printed in the reports for the Annual General Meetings of 1993/94 and 1994/95.

- 1. The Club's high-scorer is still Alasdair McClarron with 1,807 (1,475 plus 312 for 93/94 and 94/95 and 20 this season)
- 2. Second-highest is now Colin Lucas with 1,682 (1,637 at the start of this season, plus 45 this season)
- 3. James Iveson is now the third-highest with 1,601 (for all games played after 8 February 1997 the first record we have for him)
