3. Lunch at Ilkley on 16 October

Our Ist XV will travel to Ilkley for their league game on Saturday, 16 October. 4. Mini / Junior Registration Days

We hope Mini/Junior players and parents have had an enjoyable summer break and are looking forward to a new season of rugby at Driffield. This will start with a Registration Day on Sunday, 5 September. We will be in the clubhouse from 10am - 12.30pm when it will be possible for players old and new to register for the season and pay their subs.

If you are unable to attend this Sunday, we will repeat the process on Sunday, 12 September. After that, if you have been unable to make your payment you should contact your Team's Manager or Coach as soon as possible since it may not be possible to play games for the club if you are not a paid-up member, and registered with the RFU.

5. Subs for Players and Non-Playing Members

All members are reminded that their subs fall due on I September so, if you have not already taken care of them for the season we would encourage you to do so. You can pay by the methods described above. Please remember that the RFU insurance does not cover playing members until they have paid in full for the season, or have set up a Standing Order to cover the full subs.

Please remember that we will reactivate your member's discount card once you have paid for the coming season – we hold any balance on the card until then.

6. Age Grade Player Re-Affiliation

All age grade players must be registered (now called affiliation) with the RFU and, until now, the rugby club has been managing the affiliation / registration process on their behalf. From this season, parents of all age grade players will be responsible for their own children's data, easing the administration burden on volunteer club administrators.

The process is called 'Annual Affiliation'. It allows parents and players to update their details and affiliate with their chosen rugby club each year. On 4 August, all previous age grade affiliations / registrations were switched to 'Inactive' to allow parents to renew their affiliation simply through logging in, checking their existing details and saving to re-affiliate to their club for the season.
