8. Charity Bike Ride in aid of Prostate Cancer

Two of our members, Pip Snaith and Glen Witheford, took part in the Deloitte Ride Across Britain event starting on Friday, 4 September. The pair covered 970 miles in 75 hours over nine days in the saddle, travelling from Land's End to John O'Groats.

Our Ladies section took buckets around the pitch at the game against Scarborough the next day and collected £413, and the club added the £100 proceeds from the Chairman's Challenge to it. This helped the total raised by the pair to almost £5,000, a great effort. Well done to both of them.
