3. Referee Course

We are always looking for more referees for the club, and there is no commitment to join the Society. If you would like to take part in an introductory course organised by the East Yorkshire Referees Society, they have arranged a free course:

- Venue Bishop Burton College
- Date 23 and 24 November 2021
- Time 5.30pm 8.30pm

RFU-accredited trainer Brian Davison and society training officer Pete Hardman will run the course over two evenings and the course material is excellent. Brian has put the course together based on his experience with ELRA and on an introductory course devised by the London Society to encourage new referees.

The course is open to all:

- female or male
- those reaching the end of their playing career but still wanting to continue their rugby career
- Saturday players willing to referee on a Sunday
- Sunday players who are willing to referee on a Saturday
- those who wish to join the Society
- those who only wish to referee at their own club

4. Have you Verified your E-mail Address?

We have made great progress on reducing the number of unverified email addresses, down from 740 to 450, but there is still a long way to go. If you have not already done, please log into your account at https://gms.rfu.com/GMS/Dashboard/Organisation/1113

- use the account name in the footer of one of the emails from the club
- if you have multiple accounts, just choose one of the account names shown
- add a password if you have logged in before use the 'Forgotten Password' button if can't remember what you used all that time ago or have never logged
- once logged in, you should see the option to 'Resend Verification Link'
- while logged in, update any contact details and your date of birth some of them are set to 25/12/1958 as a dummy date
- the Verification Email usually takes just a few minutes to arrive (remember to check your Spam / Junk folders) but may take a while please be patient
- click the 'Verify Email' link when you receive it
