3. Off-Season Update

If you were not able to get to the AGM in July, here are some key points from the meeting - the minutes are on the website at: https://www.driffieldrufc.com/annual-general-meeting-2023/

- Rodney Hogg took over from Philip 'Pip' Snaith as President
- Adrian Harrison stood down as Hon. Sec. and Brad Webster has taken on the role
- The financial accounts for the year were positive we made a profit last season
- Membership subs are not being increased
- The current economic climate, fewer home games and more travelling will make this another tricky season
- Captains for the next season will be: Ist XV Adam Brankley; 2nd XV Matthew Rowbottom; 3rd XV Will Megginson; 4th XV Gareth Culpan; Ladies XV Laura Harris

We have started a series of improvements around the club and grounds:

- We have ordered new fencing to go around the Ist XV pitch, which should be in place for the start of the league season
- A borehole has been installed for the 1st XV pitch
- The phone system has been changed over to VOIP (an internet-based system) provided by MainTel
- The audio visual system for the club has been replaced and upgraded by local company, MH Solutions
- We have updated all the Honours Boards, the first time since 2011-12
- We have been awarded a grant to allow us to improve the fencing at the training pitches, and provide car park lighting. We hope to be able to start work soon

7. Mini Junior Registration Days

We hope Mini / Junior players and parents have had an enjoyable summer break and are looking forward to a new season of rugby at Driffield. This will start with a Registration Day on Sunday, 3 September. We will be in the clubhouse from 10am - 12.30pm when it will be possible for players old and new to register for the season and pay their subs.

If you are unable to attend this Sunday, we will repeat the process on Sunday, 10 September. After that, if you have been unable to make your payment you should contact your Team's Manager or Coach as soon as possible since it may not be possible to play games for the club if you are not a paid-up member, and registered with the RFU.

Payment details are as above, but please use Ref "Player surname year group" e.g. Smith U12.

8. Age Grade Player Registration

Parents who have not already done so should log into their RFU account to re-affiliate (now called Register) their age grade players – details of how you login are in the footer of the email that includes this newsletter. If you have received the email then you already have an account, so please do not create a new one – it will





create a duplicate. Please only create a new account for a family that is new to Driffield RUFC – you can add a child to an existing parent account.

Parents are now responsible for their own children's data, easing the administration burden on volunteer club administrators. The process allows you to check and update your details, such as a change of address. Details of how to do this are on the club's web page at:
