I. Respect for our staff, volunteers and neighbours

Dominic Thompson recently wrote to all members of the club about several recent cases where members of the club, whether senior or junior members, or parents of junior players have been disrespectful to staff and volunteers at the club. We hope that we can all recognise the value that we get from the game, which would not happen without our staff, volunteers and neighbours.

Kitchen and bar staff: these valued team members work very hard on busy Saturdays and Sundays to deliver the best service they can. On busy days like Mini / Junior Sundays and 1st XV Sponsorship days, they are victims of our own success, so can be stretched at times. Please be patient if there are delays.

Car Parking: this is operated on an entirely voluntary basis by club members, to ensure that it is both safely operated and courteous to our neighbours. Any requests they make are intended to ensure that happens.

Neighbours: Driffield Agricultural Society gives us access to their car park road, and also to the back pitches, as part of their community role. There have been several recent occasions where car drivers have parked along the access road where it is clearly marked as "No Parking". This makes access for other users of the Showground difficult or even impossible and, on occasion, has prevented them from closing their security gates.

Disrespectful, and abusive, language will not be tolerated. All members have a duty to step in where they encounter disrespect, and nip it in the bud, reminding people of our core values. The Executive Committee will not hesitate to impose bans on anyone who does not observe that.
