# 4. Charity Match and Lunch for the President's Charity: Sunday, 21 April

The Ladies Ist XV will play in bespoke kit for the rearranged game against Kendal Wasps on Sunday, 21 April. The match will be preceded by a two-course charity fund-raising lunch - funds raised will go to the President's charity, Hull and East Yorkshire Mind – one that is very close to our hearts.

Tickets for the lunch are still available, sitting down at 12:30, with lunch served at 12:45 so that diners are ready in time for the 2 pm kick-off. This will be a two-course meal at £25 per person for adults and £15 for Under 14s. # 5. Revised Arrangements for 20 / 21 April

A marquee, erected for the Mini Festival on Sunday, 14 April, will be left in place for the weekend of 20 / 21 April when a lot is happening at the club. As well as the Blackburn game, the  $2^{nd}$  XV will be hosting the Yorkshire Merit semi-final. That evening, a Sportsman's Dinner at the club means that we cannot use the main bar / dining area, so we are providing them in the marquee.

Because we are expecting a significant turnout for the games, we are looking for volunteers to help with these events.

# 6. Cardiac Risk Screening (CRY) Heart Screening on I and 2 May

Cardiac abnormalities in younger people are rare but are simple to diagnose. CRY offers subsidised screening to all young people between the ages of 14 and 35 - CRY uses a medical history questionnaire and tests carried out on the day. If one of the doctors requests it, further investigation is required.

Appointments are available on Wednesday, I and Thursday, 2 May.

The test is performed by having an ECG (electrocardiogram) test - results are read by a cardiologist. For extra clarity, an echocardiogram can also be done. If there has been a young (under 35) sudden death in the family, the family is entitled to be screened on the NHS.

Appointments must be booked and, in the first instance, are available to young people who are members of the club or their children. All CRY's public events are free to attend. To book an appointment:
